# How to Sort/Dispose of Trash

#### Common Rules

- · Bags should be no heavier than 10 kg.
- · Close bags completely to avoid spilling trash.
- Bring trash to pickup location at 8 am on pickup day.
- Remove any contents inside trash before disposal.
- Be careful of any flammable items mixed in.



#### Cloth/Linen/Paper







## Electrical Appliance Disposal

- OCheck the Trash Collection Calendar to confirm pickup day. ODo not dispose of trash in another region's collection center.
- OYou cannot dispose of electrical appliance trash in anything other than the appropriate bag.

Please use the region's collection boxes and the supermarket's recycle bins for cans, glass bottles and PET bottles whenever possible.

OWe do not collect unsorted trash.
