How to Sort/Dispose of Trash

Common Rules

- Bags should be no heavier than **10 kg**.
- Close bags completely to avoid spilling trash.
- Bring trash to pickup location at **8 am** on pickup day.
- Remove any contents inside trash before disposal.
- Be careful of any **flammable items** mixed in.

<div>Burnable Trash</div> <div>Every week on __ day</div>	<div>Kitchen waste</div> <div>Non-recyclable paper (Business card-size or smaller)</div> <div>Twigs, etc.</div>	<div></div> <div>●Food scraps, egg shells</div> <div></div> <div>●Disposable masks</div> <div></div> <div>●Tissues, carbon paper, etc.</div> <div></div> <div>●Dehumidifying packs</div> <div></div> <div>●Diapers</div> <div></div> <div>●Pet litter</div> <div></div> <div>●Twigs</div> <div></div> <div>●Cigarette ends</div> <div></div> <div>●Medicine, pills</div> <div></div> <div>●Photos etc.</div>	<div>●Cooking oil should be either hardened or completely absorbed in newspaper or cloth material.</div> <div>●Sticks should be tied into bundles and no longer than 30 cm in length and 10 cm in diameter.</div> <div>●Make sure matches and fireworks are put out completely before disposal.</div>			
<div>Recyclable Cans/Bottles</div> <div>Every week on __ day</div> <div>Cloth/Linen/Paper</div> <div>Every month on __ day</div>	<div>Cans</div> <div>Bottles</div>	<div></div> <div>●Drink cans, food cans, etc.</div> <div>※Do not crush cans.</div> <div></div> <div>●Beverage bottles, seasoning bottles, etc.</div> <div>※Dispose of broken glass bottles with Non-Burnable Trash.</div>	<div>●Dispose of metal bottles and lids with Non-Burnables, and plastic with Other Plastics.</div> <div>●Cans and bottles with labels will be collected.</div> <div>●Dispose of broken bottles with Non-Burnables.</div>			
	<div>Clothing, Linen, Paper Products</div>	<div></div> <div>●Clothing, curtains, plush dolls, etc.</div> <div></div> <div>●Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, mail, etc.</div>	<div>●Sort any futons or carpets that won't inside a bag with Large/Heavy Trash.</div> <div>●Bind the paper together then place in the appropriate bag, or put paper directly in the appropriate bag.</div>			
<div>Non-Burnable Trash</div> <div>Every week on __ day</div>	<div>①Metal Objects</div> <div>②Small Household Appliances</div> <div>③Ceramics, glass (Breakables)</div> <div>④Other Incombustibles</div>	<div>1 Metal Objects</div> <div></div> <div>●Pots, pans</div> <div></div> <div>●Knives, scissors</div> <div></div> <div>●Nails, wire, metal lids, etc.</div> <div>2 Small Household Appliances</div> <div></div> <div>●Cell phones, smartphones</div> <div></div> <div>●Irons, electrical cords</div> <div></div> <div>●Fluorescent lights, batteries, disposable lighters, etc.</div> <div>3 Ceramics, glass (Breakables)</div> <div></div> <div>●Ceramics (tea cups)</div> <div></div> <div>●Glass dishware and vases</div> <div></div> <div>●Broken thermometers, glass, mirrors, etc.</div> <div>4 Other Incombustibles</div> <div></div> <div>●Shoes</div> <div></div> <div>●Ice packs, thermal gels</div> <div></div> <div>●Bags, leather goods</div> <div></div> <div>●Metal, wood, plastic mixed items (Toys, etc.) etc.</div>	<div>●Use separate appropriate bags for each trash category.</div> <div>●Use a clear, smaller bag for items like nails and lids.</div> <div>●Umbrellas and fluorescent lights that stick out of the bags will also be collected.</div> <div>●Remove anything inside of items containing batteries.</div> <div>●For dangerous items like knives, wrap in paper and write "Broken" or "Dangerous" before disposal.</div>			
<div>Plastic Trash PET Bottles</div> <div>Every month on __ day</div> <div>Other Plastics</div> <div>Every week on __ day</div>	<div>PET Bottles</div> <div>Other Plastics</div>	<div>①Remove cap.</div> <div></div> <div>②Remove label.</div> <div></div> <div>③Rinse clean.</div> <div></div> <div>④Crush.</div> <div></div> <div>PET Bottles for mineral water, tea, juice, soy sauce, etc.</div> <div></div> <div>●Bento packs</div> <div></div> <div>●Styrofoam</div> <div></div> <div>●Snack bags</div> <div></div> <div>●Gas tanks</div> <div></div> <div>●Plastic bags</div> <div></div> <div>●Plastic Packaging</div> <div></div> <div>●Food trays</div> <div></div> <div>●Plastic buckets etc.</div>	<div>●Discard caps, labels with "Other Plastics".</div> <div>Look for this mark. (The number must be 1)</div> <div></div> <div>●Rinse clean any dirty items like bento packs before disposal.</div> <div>Look for this mark.</div> <div></div>			
<div>Large/Heavy Trash</div> <div>(on designated date)</div>	<div>Items that cannot fit inside an appropriate bag or weigh over 10 kg.</div>	<div>●One futon ●One set of skis ●One carpet</div> <div>●One set of golf clubs ●One tatami mat, etc.</div> <div>★Bring any items that weigh over 70 kg directly to Poccle.</div> <div></div>	<div>●Please dispose of trash at the designated center for "Large/Heavy Trash". Attach the ticket where clearly visible.</div> <div>●Check where the region's pickup centers are.</div>			
<div>Electrical Appliances</div> <div>(on designated date)</div>	<div>Recyclable Electrical Appliances</div>	<div>★If possible, please arrange for a pickup from the store where purchased.</div> <div>(Up to 4 items per collection day)</div> <div>●Air Conditioner (including outdoor unit)</div> <div>●Televisions (CRT, liquid crystal, plasma)</div> <div>●Refrigerators, freezers (including hot storage)</div> <div>●Clothes washers, dryers</div> <div></div>	<div>①Request a recycling ticket from the Post Office.</div> <div>※Costs vary for product type and maker.</div> <div>②Apply for pickup with the town hall up until the day before pickup day. (Ask about door-to-door pickup).</div> <div>• There is an additional pickup service cost for each item.</div> <div>• Take out anything from inside the machines.</div>			
<div>Non-Collectible Trash</div>	<div>●Industrial waste ●Medical waste ●Tires ●Concrete lumps ●Fire extinguishers ●Pesticides ●Waste oil</div> <div>●Poisonous substances ●Batteries ●Vehicles ●Motorcycles (Including Scooters) ●Paint-Filled Paint Cans</div> <div>●Ink Cartridges ●Gas Tanks, Cylinders ●Ashes ●Safes ●Oil heaters ●Drywall</div> <div>★Contact the organization or vendor where purchased to inquire how to dispose of these items.</div> <div>●Computers</div> <div>(Including: Desktop computers, laptops, CTR displays, liquid crystal displays, monitors)</div> <div>The Association of Computer Recycling ☎03-5282-7685 (https://www.pc3r.jp)</div> <div>Contact the organization above or manufacturer regarding how to recycle computers.</div> <div></div>

※ Please confirm end and start of the year pickups.

9:00am-12:00am, 1:00pm-4:30pm

○ We are unavailable outside of business hours.

○ Please bring in your trash sorted.

○ Service fees differ based on trash category.

Electrical Appliance Disposal

○ Check the Trash Collection Calendar to confirm pickup day.

○ Do not dispose of trash in another region's collection center.

○ You cannot dispose of electrical appliance trash in anything other than the appropriate bag.

○ We do not collect unsorted trash.
