The outer bag used to contain designated bags for household garbage may now be used as a designated bag for non-burnable garbage.

From April 2022, all outer bags of designated household garbage bags (the outer bags that are used to contain designated bags when being sold for purchase) may now be used as a designated bag for non-burnables.

By doing this, we are able to efficiently reuse the outer bags and also provide a smaller-sized bag for non-burnable garbage.

<u>Please be sure to only put in items that fit inside the outer bag.</u>

[Precautions when using the outer bags]

- You may only dispose of "Non-burnable garbage' in the outer bag.
- Separate the non-burnable trash in the same way and be sure to put them in separate bags.
- When using the outer bag, make sure the items enclosed do not come out by taping the bag with packing tape.
- If the items are too long and do not completely fit into the outer bag, please use a regularsized designated garbage bag.
- You **may not** use the outer bag of industrial garbage bags.
- You **must not** dispose of industrial garbage in the outer bags.
